## Minutes, May 3, 2016 Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Derry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order in the Municipal Building at 5321 Route 982, Derry, PA at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited..

Terry Giannini, Ordinance Enforcement Officer gave a list of materials that can be burned; such as paper and wood.

Junk automobiles in backyards must have current inspections and current registrations on vehicles.
